The deeply moving production tells the compelling story of Lieutenant Colonel Vivian Bullwinkel and her fellow nurses, honouring their courage, service, and the tragic events of the Banka Island massacre during the Second World War. Through the power of live performance, the audience will experience a uniquely personal and shared connection to Bullwinkel's remarkable life and legacy, and the vital contributions of Australian women in wartime.
